CIRCULAR

Of late, it is noticed that the staff who apply for permission/intimation for purchase / disposal of immovable property are submitting their applications after the transaction is completed and seek condonation for the lapse on the ground that they were not aware of the Rule position or for some other reason. Rule 18(2) of CCS (Conduct) Rules is reproduced below for guidance.

“No Government servant shall, except with the previous knowledge of the prescribed authority, acquire or dispose of any immovable property by lease, mortgage, purchase, sale, gift or otherwise either in his own name or in the name of any member of his family:

Provided that the previous sanction of the prescribed authority shall be obtained by the Government servant if any such transaction is with a person having official dealings with him.”

Staff members are hereby instructed to comply with the provisions of Rule 18(2) of CCS (Conduct) Rules and apply for permission/intimation before entering into such transactions regarding purchase/disposal of immovable property. **Any violation of this rule will be viewed seriously and appropriate action will be initiated.**
